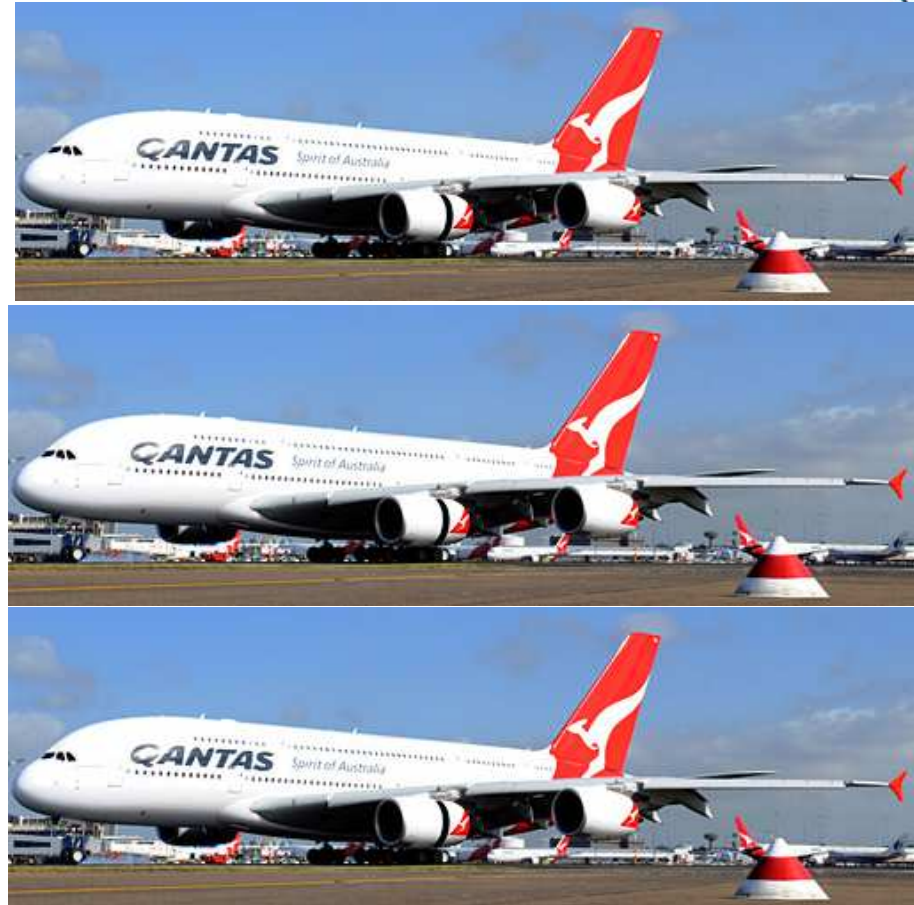

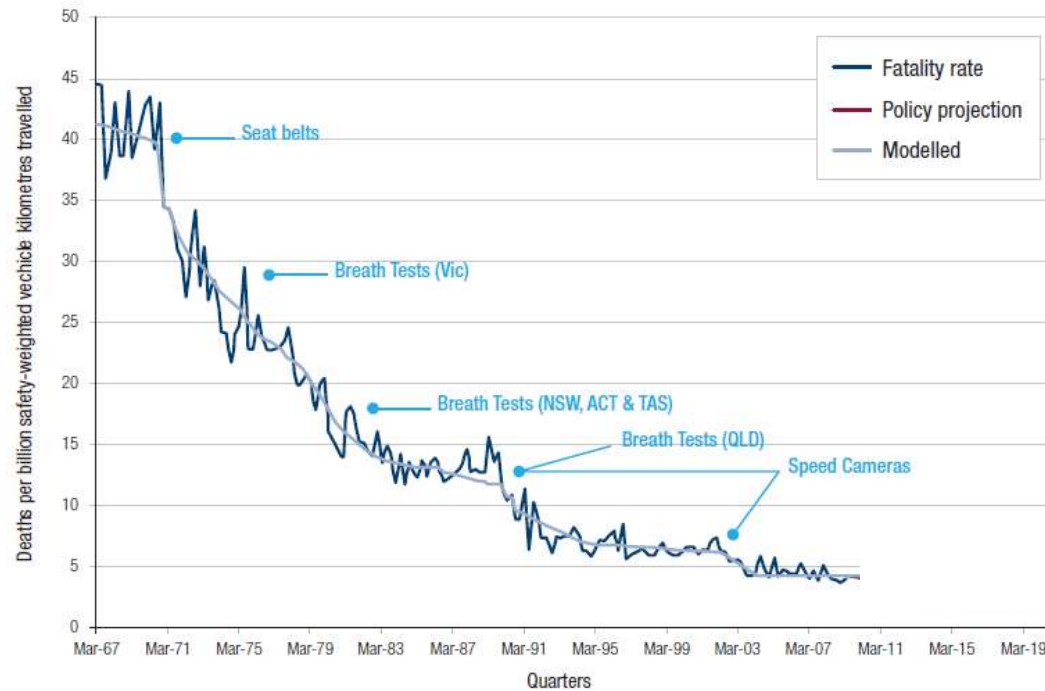
# Setting the scene

# Objective of the National Road Safety Strategy 2011-20



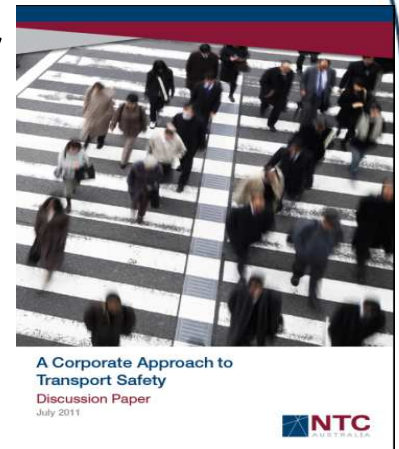
# Why the workplace – The Facts

- Road crashes est. cost Australia \$18 billion/annum
- Work related road crashes are 50% of all occupational fatalities and 15% of national road deaths
- Company drivers travel twice the annual distance and have 50% more incidents
- Corporate decisions affect safety culture and \$\$\$
- The road environment is No.1 business risk for most organisations



# A corporate approach to transport safety

- What can private sector organisations do to contribute to the National Road Safety Strategy targets?
  - Recognise influence of business (not just transport industry)
  - Road safety is a shared responsibility – not just government
- Identify things entirely within the control of an individual company
- Recognise need to benefit company – not just altruistic corporate social responsibility
